





What is a CV?




- Your document

- Closing date for applications Monday 17th October at 12 noon
- Friday 21st: Pitch details circulated for students and organisations (2) per group)
- Friday 28th 1-3pm Pitch Day
- Wednesday 2 November: allocation day and work begins


